




# DAILY MORNING PRAYER

## DAILY MORNING PRAYER

### OPENING SONG:

You may sing or play some meditative or praise music.

### CONFESSION OF SIN

*Leader:* Send out your light and your truth,  
that they may lead us,  
and bring us to your holy hill and to your dwelling.

*Leader:* Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor.

*Silence may be kept.*

*All together:*

***Most merciful God,  
we confess that we have sinned against you  
in thought, word, and deed,  
by what we have done,  
and by what we have left undone.  
We have not loved you with our whole heart;  
we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.  
We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.  
For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ,  
have mercy on us and forgive us;  
that we may delight in your will,  
and walk in your ways,  
to the glory of your Name. Amen.***

*The leader says:*

Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us all your sins through our Lord Jesus Christ, strengthen us in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep us in eternal life.

*All:* ***Amen.***

## THE INVITATORY AND PSALTER

*Leader:* Lord, open our lips.

*All:* ***And our mouth shall proclaim your praise.***

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit:

***As it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.***

## VENITE

Come, let us sing to the Lord;

***let us shout for joy to the Rock of our salvation.***

Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving

Save your people, Lord, and bless your inheritance;  
***Govern them and uphold them, now and always.***

Day by day we bless you;  
***We praise your name for ever.***

Lord, keep us from all sin today;  
***Have mercy upon us, Lord, have mercy.***

Lord, show us your love and mercy;  
***For we put our trust in you.***

In you, Lord, is our hope;  
***And we shall never hope in vain.***

in holiness and righteousness all our days;  
through Jesus Christ our Lord,  
to whom, with you and the Holy Spirit,  
be honor and glory throughout all ages. Amen.*
